Suggested Prayer Points

In addition to the following suggested prayer issues; look for opportunities to thank, praise and worship God for His creation, provision, faithfulness... etc!!

You may also wish to pray for an opportunity on your walk, and in the days ahead, to be salt and light.

And, as you walk – Keep in step with the Spirit!

Walk 1 – Dan Albone, Shortmead, Railway, Furzenhall; 4km / 2.5km

- Sports pitches – the town's clubs & societies, that they will be positive influences on our children and community
- Shortmead House – a wedding venue; that Christian marriage will be promoted and protected in the town
- Railway – for safety for all users; for blessing for Christian's travelling to their places of work
- Countryside – that we will be good stewards of God's creation and that wise planning decisions will be made
- Furzenhall area – for local residents, those using the community centre Warm Space; & the community garden

Walk 2 – Furzenhall, Biggleswade Common; 3.4km / 2.1m

- Furzenhall area – for local residents, those using the community centre Warm Space; & the community garden
- Countryside – that we will be good stewards of God's creation and that wise planning decisions will be made
- Safety on the roads as they get busier - especially on school routes
- Health Provision for the town – that the most vulnerable are prioritised in planning and decision making

Walk 3 – Kings Reach, Stratton School, Drove Road, Potton Rd, The Pastures (Biggleswade Common); 5.2km / 3.2m

- Countryside – that we will be good stewards of God's creation and that wise planning decisions will be made
- The schools of our town – that they will be safe spaces for learning and growth. For pupils and staff
- Kings Corner – that our work within Kings Reach is led by God and is fruitful for His Kingdom
- Kings Reach – local residents, especially the lonely and isolated lost in a highly populated area

Walk 4 – Saxon Drive Linear Woods, Jubilee Wood; 2.75km / 1.7m

- Countryside – that we will be good stewards of God's creation and that wise planning decisions will be made
- Saxon Leisure Centre – that we & our community will seek Godly spiritual fitness & wellbeing; as well as physical
- Allotments / food / shops – that our Food Bank & the VBDS will meet the need; and that the need will reduce
- Health Provision for the town – that the most vulnerable are prioritised in planning and decision making

Walk 5 – Franklins Rec, Jordans, Railway (take care!), Home Wood, Station; 5.8km / 3.6m

- Recreation grounds and play areas across the town – that they will be safe and free from dark influences
- The River – that those in authority will be wise in water resource management, for healthy people and planet
- Jordans / local businesses – that they will be good employers and positive contributors to our community
- Railway – for safety for all users; for blessing for Christian's travelling to their places of work
